In 2019, Sanofi launched the Rare Diseases University (RDU) with the first of our rare disease Foundation programs focusing on Fabry disease. The first semester of the second Foundation program, on acid sphingomyelinase deficiency (ASMD), launched in September 2020. The second semester for ASMD and the Advanced programs for both Fabry disease and ASMD launched in 2022.

This program has been developed and driven by Sanofi hand-in-hand with an expert faculty. This faculty is at the heart of the RDU and comprises globally renowned clinicians.

The RDU platform offers:

A dynamic syllabus – The RDU provides the opportunity for HCPs to expand their current knowledge on rare lysosomal storage diseases through content ranging from quick overviews to in-depth concepts.

Community learning activities – The RDU offers networking and peer-to-peer scientific exchange opportunities with other participants from around the world.

Media-rich resources – The RDU is a valuable and unique educational resource curated to ensure that the content is engaging and current; it includes interactive case studies, and journal clubs,

Progress tracking – The RDU tracks each participant's learning journey, keeping them updated with their achievements and progress.

The ASMD curriculum

The ASMD curriculum covers all aspects of ASMD from pathophysiology, identification and diagnosis, to clinical management of the disease and symptoms. In particular the following will be explored:

- Inheritance and pathophysiology
- The ASMD phenotypic spectrum and genotype-phenotype relationships
- Natural history and disease manifestations
- Challenges around diagnosing ASMD, diagnostic algorithms and possible differential diagnoses
- Symptomatic disease management

The patient and caregiver perspective is explored throughout the curriculum to provide context and real-world understanding of the topics.
